COUNCIL 2792—this council stopped meetings and all activity because of the Pandemic. Four months later they began meeting in person with very low attendance. It has continued its meetings in person with low member attendance and few activities but still motivating absent members to help with the few FIA programs. The council has added 2 new members to the council for a 33% of Their quota and gained 3 insurance members making the council eligible for the Founders award. All the required forms have been submitted and the council is Safe Environment compliant.

COUNCIL 5444—This council is a small council but very active. The Pandemic did not hold them back long from holding in person meetings, and even though low member attendance at meetings the general membership has been motivated to help with FIA programs. The council met their membership quota recruiting 3 new members for a 100% membership gain. The council is Safe Environment compliant And all of the required reports have been submitted and up to date. This council May be eligible for the McGivney award .

COUNCIL 12881—This council has been inactive since the Pandemic, the council did not have meetings and was inactive for about 10 months. In February 2021 the council had a Degree Exemplification night with the help of our State Deputy And a Supreme Hispanic representative, one new member was initiated for a gain of 25% of their membership quota and 4 members were advanced to the 2nd and 3rd degrees. After this Exemplification the council scheduled regular in person Meetings for the rest of the year and they have already met with their first meeting bringing in 18 members. The council has submitted all of their required reports, but still are not Safe Environment compliant.
